 - Concerns: we don't have any sense that we would be able to gather in June.

 - Delaying until August but no sign that things will be better by then
 - Graduates could be concerned for the ceremony coinciding with Boards (which date is still to be determined)
 - Worst case scenario: this year's graduates would be invited to the ceremony next year
 - Is there any way we can support morale during this time as many of the graduates' events will not be able to occur (grad party, ceremony, etc.)
